This equipment must be assembled and checked by an adult. Two adults may be required to assemble this product.

Adult supervision is required at all times.

Before use please check all bolts are tight, secure and intact.

Check all coverings for bolts and sharp edges and replace when required.

Check bars and attachments if relevant to your product for evidence of deterioration. Replace when required in accordance with the manufacturers instructions if necessary.

Place the product on level surface at least 2 metres from any structure or obstruction such as a fence, garage, house, wall, overhanging branches, laundry line or electrical wires.

DO NOT install the product over concrete, asphalt or any hard surface.

DO NOT orientate the product directly towards the sun.

Leave all fittings finger tight until assembly is complete, for ease of construction. Then tighten firmly. Children should not wear cycle helmets whilst on this equipment.

Do not allow loose, hooded or baggy clothes to be worn as children can get trapped and may be unable to free themselves.

Do not allow children to climb on parts of this equipment not intended for this purpose.

Do not allow children to wander into the play area whilst the equipment is in use.

Regularly check the item for wear and damage, removing the item from use when necessary until replacement parts are fitted.




Assemble as illustrated below.

Lay the round base using tubes A and B, and connect them together with bolts. DO NOT FIT NUT AT THIS STAGE.



HINT: The screws go through from the inside out.

The convex side of the tube always faces inward of the dome.


HINT: The screws go through from the inside out.


Do not fully tighten the nuts at this stage.

STEP 3: Assembly

Assemble as illustrated below.

Assemble four hexagons (Step 2) onto the round base (Step 1). Join two tube C from one hexagon to tube B on the base using bolt. DO NOT FIX WIH NUT AT THIS STAGE







Assemble as illustrated below.

Join the hexagons together by adding two Tube B to Tube A on base, fix with nut. Connect a third Tube B using nut to lock in place.


Now the base on the dome is completed.





Assemble as illustrated below.


Connect the top of the hexagons using final four Tube B, fixing in place with nut.



STEP 6 : Assembly

Assemble as illustrated below.

Join the final Tube A to the top square, replacing nut afterwards.



HINT: Please fully tighten all the bolts and nuts until snug.

STEP 7 : Assembly


Small Node (8 pcs)

Large Node (12 pcs)

Allen Key (1pc)


Assemble as illustrated below.

Cover the joins of the base with the small nodes x 8. Cover the joins of remaining structure with large nodes x 8. Use the allen key to tighten the nodes in place.




IMPORTANT: Ensure the notch of large node fits over the top of the tube join.

STEP 8: Assembly




STEP 9 Anchoring the Dome Climber
